National Migration Week 2016

A Stranger and You Welcomed Me

In the Gospel of Matthew (25:35) tells his disciples, "I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me." The call to welcome the stranger plays an important role in the lives of faithful Christians and has a particularly central place for those who work in the migration field. The migrant, who moves from one country to another is truly a stranger in the midst. Often unfamiliar with the local tongue of the new country, not to mention its customs, the migrant needs the support of local communities so that they can better adjust to their new surroundings. National Migration Week 2016 picks up on the theme of welcome and, in doing so, calls on each of us to welcome the stranger among us.

Our St. Vincent de Paul Society provides significant assistance to families in the Mt. Healthy area who struggle with difficult economic circumstances. Thanks to you kind and generous support, we have been able to make a difference for many in the community. Your support has allowed our SVDP volunteers to give assistance with payments, such as the following made in the last three months: Utilities - 45 families, Rent - 15 families and Medical – 7 individuals. In addition, we provided volunteer workers and donated \$675.00 to the Mt. Healthy Alliance Food Pantry for food purchases during this period, distributed clothing vouchers, and made referrals for issues where we were not able to help. We assisted with arrangements for the organizing committee for the Christmas Angel children's gift project to collect organize and distribute Christmas gifts to children. Our volunteers give over 300 hours every month for these and other services. All of these activities could not have happened, or can continue, without the help of many parish volunteers and the generous donations that come from the parish. We and those we serve are very grateful for your help. Please pray for them and the success of our efforts.
