Hospital Stays

This week I received a mailing from Good Samaritan Hospital's Pastoral Care Department which contained some reminders for when someone has a hospital stay. I found them to be good reminders and directions not only for Good Samaritan Hospital but for all the Catholic hospitals and for situations for other area hospitals: Area Catholic hospitals want to support you spiritually when you are admitted into our hospitals. Here are a few reminders from the Pastoral Care Department at Good Samaritan Hospital:

- 1. Upon admission, tell them you are Catholic. This will enable them to be placed on their Holy Communion list.
- 2. Notify your parish you are in the hospital. Due to HIPPA laws, Pastoral Care Chaplains are unable to call your parish unless they have your permission.
- 3. If you are undergoing surgery, ask your parish priest to provide the Sacrament of the Sick BEFORE you come to the hospital. Due to the fewer number of priests, it is very challenging to call a priest at the last minute.
- 4. Ask your nurse to call a chaplain (if applicable to the hospital)! They are there to serve you. They will come to your room and offer spiritual care and help answer questions, provide communion and help contact your parish.
