### Respect Life Sunday 2016

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati will celebrate Respect Life Sunday next weekend, October 1/2. This year's theme from the USCCB is "**Moved by Mercy**" – We are called to show mercy because mercy has first been shown to us – Pope Francis. As

each person "has a place in God's heart from all eternity" (Amoris Laetitia 168), Pope Francis reminds us "we are called to protect our humanity, and this means, in the first place, accepting it and respecting it as it was created" (AL 56).

With this celebration we participate in the Respect Life Collection taken at all the weekend Sunday masses. Through this voluntary second collection our parish is given the opportunity to contribute to the LIFE work of many Pro Life organizations throughout the 19 counties of the Archdiocese. Various organizations apply for these funds sent to the Archdiocese through the annual grant process of the Office for Respect Life Ministry.

### In the Month of October

- The October Count is taken at all Sunday Masses during the month of October. This annual count of persons attending masses taking place from the beginning anticipation Mass on Saturday evening through the Sunday evening hours is required by the Archdiocese. It is an important marker for parish life and growth for the Archdiocese. With the month of October bringing many other schedules and outside activities I encourage your attendance at Assumption Church.
