Lenten Penance Service for Pastoral Region: 3-28-17

Another opportunity for the Sacrament of Reconciliation takes place in our pastoral region on March 28 as we hold a Lenten Penance Service at St. Margaret Mary Church at 7:00 p.m.

Lenten reminders - regulations regarding fast and abstinence:

The Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years and older. With regard to the obligatory days listed above, however, there are frequent questions about the degree of seriousness of the matter. The teaching of Pope John Paul II are recalled: *the obligation to do penance is a serious one; the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially," the penitential days specified by the Church is also serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe an individual day of penance is not considered serious.*
